alexander hagner founded the architecture team gaupenraub+/- together with ulrike schartner in 1999. he studied at the university of applied arts, first for 3 years at johannes spalt, then for 5 years at wolf d. prix, where he graduated with honours. one of gaupenraub's most important projects is the egg museum for the sculptor wander bertoni in winden am see. in addition, hagner has been increasingly involved in projects for disadvantaged people for over 10 years, such as the *vinzirast* emergency shelter, the realisation of the *memobil*, a piece of furniture for dementia patients, and the *vinzirast-mittendrin*, a building for homeless people and students to live together. at the same time, hagner has taken on external teaching assignments since 2000, including at the tu vienna and most recently a guest professorship. Since 2016, he has been a professor of social building at the faculty of architecture and civil engineering - carinthia university of applied sciences. (fh-kaernten.at)
